Dear Colleagues,


The University of Athens, School of Medicine, Post-graduate Programme “Global Health – Disaster Medicine” is pleased to welcome you to the 1st International Conference “People on the move” that will take place in the island of Lesvos between October 16th and October 20th 2019.

This original idea aims to train both our post-graduate students and the local community in the possible challenges of a mass refugee influx. By providing them with all the necessary theoretical knowledge and practical skills required, the participants get acquainted with the refugee context and learn how to safeguard the right to health when dealing with health emergencies connected to population movements. Our vision is to pursue a more structured approach to refugee reception procedures and to develop healthcare professionals with profound global knowledge and strong humanitarian values able to provide high-quality healthcare services to incoming populations.

The agenda of the conference includes carefully planned lectures on modern aspects of the refugee influx including sea rescue, pre-hospital healthcare provision, reception camp planning, prevention of epidemics, vulnerability assessment etc. Experienced professionals working in the already existing refugee response mechanism will ensure an efficient educational program that best fits the participants’ needs and the local context. Moreover, the involvement of the local society has a binary effect in building capacity to the local staff and to the seminar’s participants by facilitating experience sharing through real-life examples.

For this 1st International Conference “People on the move” we have strategically chosen the island of Lesvos. Being the most crowded reception island in Greek territory, Lesvos provides the perfect surroundings for participants to experience the existing challenges faced by the response mechanism developed so far. Even more, the collaboration of the two universities (University of Athens & Aegean University) sets the ground for transforming the island to a local matrix for future research and training in dealing with mass population movements.

We firmly believe to a high-quality conference in every aspect and we address thankful considerations to all the authorities in Lesvos involved mainly in it.
